

Psychiatric Liaison Service

The Psych Liaison Service is designed to enable anyone not currently open to CMHT or CRHT to access the support they deserve.

We do this by offering up to 12 weeks of support where we can rapidly identify their needs, make appropriate referrals and offer emotional and practical support, this is done on a 1:1 basis in the community.



About Our Psychiatric Liaison Service

What we do:

- Make first contact with client within 4 working days of referral.
- Allocate Liaison worker within 5 working days of making contact with the client.
- Offer a comprehensive assessment to identify support needs.
- Complete all appropriate referrals.
- Providing weekly face to face or telephone support sessions, offering emotional and practical support throughout their time in Mind's Psych Liaison Service.

How and who to refer:

- Anyone aged 18+ admitted into QEH, NNUH and JPUH not currently open to CMHT or CRHT is able to be referred into Mind's Psych Liaison service.
- The Three Mental Health Liaison Teams across the QEH, NNUH and JPUH have access to our quick and easy referral form.
- Email referral to the referrals inbox.
