Who can use our service?

- People receiving structured treatment from CGL.
- People who desire to start working as soon as they are referred to our service.
- People who are over the age of 18 who are unemployed and with the right to work in the UK.

What happens next?

- Ask your recovery coordinator to make a referral to our service.
- You will be contacted by an Employment Specialist to tell you more about the service and arrange regular appointments.
- Your Employment Specialist will help you develop a back to work plan and support you into employment.
- When you start work your Employment Specialist will continue to work with you to help ensure everything goes smoothly.
